

Child Care

Child care will be provided at all PTO meetings. This will be provided by members of the Junior National Honor Society and a minimum of 1 PTO volunteer. We will utilize room 108 (the room closest to the cafeteria) as well as the gym when available. Please send children in sturdy footwear as well as clothes that may become dirty from play/crafts. Children must be potty-trained to attend childcare.

Sign In

You will be asked to sign your child in with a representative at each meeting no earlier than 6:45pm in room 108. Please do not just send children in.

Expectations of Children

Children will be expected to follow school rules as well as obey the volunteers. We ask that children not of school age are given basic rules to follow such as no running and using an indoor voice. If your child does not follow the rules, you will be informed. If we continue to have problems, we will ask that you keep your child with you at meetings.

Expectations of Parents

All parents that utilize the child care program whether it be for one meeting or every meeting will be asked to volunteer a minimum of one PTO meeting per school year in child care. You will be expected to sign up for a meeting the first time that you utilize the child care service. This will ensure that all parents using will sign up and lend a hand.

Expectations of Child Care Chairs

Rose Henning and Beth Shirk are the PTO Child Care Co-chairs. They will provide the volunteers a list of events/activities to do with the children at each meeting as well as the equipment/materials necessary. They will ensure that an adult is with the children at each meeting. They will handle speaking to parents if children are not following rules, etc.

Sign Out

At the end of the meeting, we ask that you get your children prior to socializing. Our child care volunteers are there to provide a service during our meeting. We do not want to take advantage. You are more than welcome to bring your children back to the cafeteria for a snack and to socialize.
