Question asked- do the books go to Classrooms yes, each teacher gets a Wish list and we try to fulfill the entire wish list.
- f. Halloween Dance: Amy Carrelli/Stephanie White: Michele gave report, 144 students attended went well. Lots of help, and to set up. Thank you.
- g. Fall Festivities/Parade: MaryJo King/Sue Novak except for small rain shower in AM- it went well. Assembly of bags went well. Thank you to everyone that came out on Parade day. We need a co-chair to replace Tricia.

h. Fundraisers:

Bomber Bracelet Fundraiser: Melissa Hager: finally heard back after 4 weeks of no response. Posted on Facebook, and email, and goes out this Wed express. Short sale so can be in for Christmas, Orders in for Nov 25. Need them next Wed before Thanksgiving. Going to Towamensing. Need a copy person. \$20 each. Kid's size is for 8yrs and up. The P bomber is cut-out with 2 crystals. Blue & white. Question is if we get 75 orders, should we order extra to sell- Michele suggested 10 extra, We could potentially do it in spring -and if they run a no-minimum sale we can do that. Some other items - a keychain, a paracord keychain, only minimum of 25. Members think we should wait for spring for anything else. We sold 230 bracelets last year. We can't get them for Christmas in the Park. We can order more extra, and take orders at the Christmas in Park. We should be able to sell the extra- we shouldn't lose. Kristy Gable makes a motion to order 25, Wendy Bartholomew makes second. All in favor, no one opposed. Question to add charm with Graduation year - but we can't do because it would be another custom order of 75 minimum.

- 2. Christmas In the Park: Melissa Hager: a new dumpling provider will order 150; Sign-up will go out for other supplies. We don't know how much we will sell. Gift cards for Country Harvest to get cheese, milk. Need people to brainstorm on amount of pasta she needs. Jenn Lesher has a generator. Rain date only if torrential rain/snow, light snow or rain still goes on. 12-5 pm. Trees lit at 4:30. Set up around 10:30am.
- 3. Spirit Wear: Steph Bollinger/Michelle Burkett approx. 270 items sold, made \$514 on sale. Delivery date not yet. Emails will go out when we have a date.
- 4. Vendor/Craft Event: Michelle Gordon-Vendors: Thank you to all who came out and it was very successful. We doubled our vendors, increased attendance. This year- \$1822 and only \$70 used on budget. Many vendors interested in next year. Over 150 filled out door prize how they came- We will advertise again next year- 1/3 of people saw it in the Times News, brought in bigger crowd. We didn't have the confusion of yard sale items etc.
 Kristi Gable-Food sales -A lot of donations and help. \$384 and change in profit. Sold out of food. DD donated 10dz for event- sold those too.
- 5. KidsStuff Books: Jen Tobia/Becky Christman: Please send in payment or book. We need to wrap this up. You don't have to sell it. Sales so far are down- We missed out because of it going out late. Many already bought it- especially since Towamensing sold before us. We will discuss and probably move back to sending out in the first week of school next year.
- 6. Box Tops: Wendi Bartholomew sent in first mailing for \$159.70. Please watch the dates- we get many expired that get thrown out. Keeping track by grades- then will do reward at end of year, for the whole grade, not by classroom.
