Call meeting to order @ 7:05 pm.

Minutes from September Meeting: (Anne Cronk) Given by Michele -Anne is not here- Minutes will be taken by Michelle and Melissa for this meeting. No questions/corrections. Motion to accept made by Sue Novak; 2nd by Mary Hermann.

Treasurer's Report: Melissa Hager: We are in good financial shape right now. We can spend some money. Currently we are working on Taxes due Nov. 15. Motion to accept made by Mary Hermann, 2nd by Kristy Gable.

Old Business/Committee Reports

- a. Fundraisers
 - i. KidsStuff Books (Jen Tobia/Becky Christman) Sale is over. Please remember to return or purchase books. 40 books outstanding right now. \$2500 profit right now.
 - ii. Bomber Fun Run (Tiff Lakatosh-Brown) Fun Run went GREAT! Total raised as of today is \$10,092, final numbers given at Nov. meeting. Expenses so far- \$1,069. All prizes should be out to students this week. Thank you to everyone for volunteering and donating! Michele added a thank you to committee for all their work and the volunteers!
 - iii. BoxTops: (Wendi Bartholmew) Given by Michele use the Mobile App to take a picture of your receipt that includes items with boxtops- get bonus \$. If you screen shot and print out your confirmation-send in to school for classroom credit. Emails will be sent out for clipping. Current-\$857 earned. Checks come in Dec and April.
- b. Fall Festivities October 27, Assembly: Thurs. Oct 26, 6pm (Sue Novak/MJ King) Held Friday 10/27 in the afternoon. Assembly at King Residence. Flyers with parade route will be sent home this Wed. A lot of help is needed to put together goodie bags. Ask that no children attend that meeting so it can remain a surprise. Alsono children may hand out the bags on Friday. We have allergy-sensitive bags that need to be distributed to the right children and we need to ensure the children get the correct bag. Jenn Sommers will check to see if Scholastic has these available to purchase using scholastic dollars.

Bomber Fun Run Pie-Throwing Reward Assembly- Date is November 17 at 2pm. K-6 grade will attend. Children that raised the most money will get the throw the pies.
